## Nursing Order Form for Medication Injections at Cornell Health

### PATIENT:

If you have a medication prescription from a **provider outside of Cornell Health**, you will need the following before a Cornell Health staff member can administer the medication:

- 1) A **prescription for the medication** (either bring the prescribed medication with you, or pick up the medication at the Cornell Health Pharmacy located on Level 4);
- 2) A **Nursing Order** to administer the medication (this completed form). If the form is not completed by the time of your scheduled medication injection appointment, please re-schedule your appointment.

- 1) Ask your prescribing clinician to complete the form below. Keep in mind, nursing orders must be updated annually for each injectable medication you are prescribed.
- 2) Provide the completed form to Cornell Health via one of the methods below:
  - a. Bring the completed form with you to the scheduled appointment, along with your medication;
  - b. FAX to our health records department at **607-255-0269**;
  - c. Upload the form via your MyCornellHealth portal (from the Home screen click on **“Messages”**, then **“New Message”**, then **“Send message or attachment to Health Records”**).

**PROVIDER:** Please complete all fields legibly. This form is a nursing order to administer the prescribed medication for your patient. If you have questions please call 607-255-5155, Option#1 to speak to a Registered Nurse or Option#5 for the Pharmacy.
